

EXPOSURE VISIT TO MUNDERI FARM

As part of Project Sanjeevini under Project Aadi, Oleevia Foundation organized an exposure visit for members of the Sanjeevini Self Help Group (SHG) to Munderi Farm, Nilambur, in collaboration with the Agriculture Department, Palakkad. The visit aimed to provide experiential learning, practical insights, and direct exposure to sustainable farming practices, enabling participants to strengthen their agricultural knowledge and enhance confidence in modern cultivation techniques.

Bridging Knowledge and Practice

The visit was designed to bridge theoretical understanding with real-world agricultural applications. Participants engaged in interactive sessions on soil management, crop diversification, organic inputs, irrigation methods, and pest control. Direct interaction with farmers and agricultural experts helped Sanjeevini SHG members understand scalable farming models, best practices, and innovative techniques that can be adapted to their 7.5-acre farming initiative at Naduppathy.



Empowering Livelihood Aspirations

This exposure visit significantly strengthened the livelihood aspirations of the SHG members. Observing successful agricultural models in action inspired participants to adopt disciplined farming practices, explore value-added cultivation, and approach farming as a sustainable enterprise. The learning experience enhanced their confidence, entrepreneurial thinking, and collective responsibility, reinforcing Oleevia Foundation's goal of transforming tribal livelihoods through empowerment and participation.
