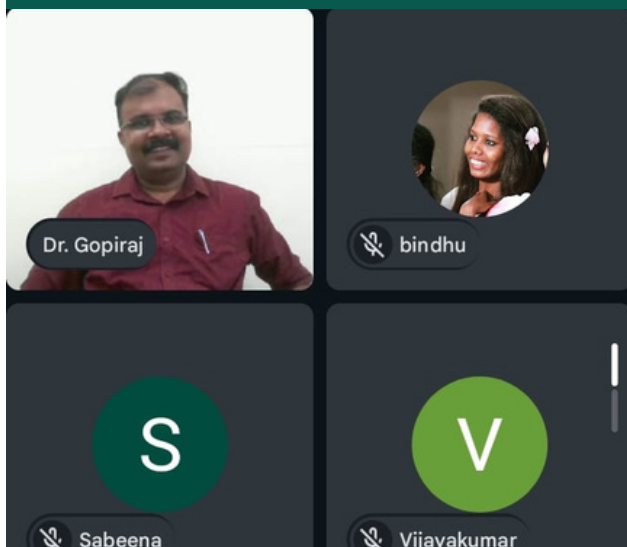
Building Skills for Collective Progress

The interactive online session focused on enhancing essential life and leadership skills, including communication, problem-solving, teamwork, and self-confidence. Through engaging discussions and participatory learning methods, participants explored practical approaches to community mobilization and grassroots leadership. The training encouraged members to identify their strengths, overcome limitations, and assume responsible leadership roles within the SHG and the broader village ecosystem.



Understanding Disability with Empathy and Inclusion

A key highlight of the online program was an insightful module on disability awareness, which sensitized participants to the diverse needs of persons with disabilities within tribal communities. The session fostered empathy, inclusion, and respect, while providing practical guidance on identifying disabilities, ensuring accessibility, and promoting social inclusion.



Strengthening Community Survey and Planning Skills

Participants also received comprehensive online training on conducting systematic and ethical community surveys, enabling them to collect accurate data for project planning and implementation. The session enhanced their understanding of household mapping, need assessment, and documentation, equipping them to play a vital role in shaping evidence-based development interventions.



Awakening Inner Potential and Collective Responsibility

The session concluded with renewed confidence, emotional strength, and a deep sense of collective responsibility among participants. Empowered with knowledge and purpose, Sanjeevini SHG members emerged as catalysts of change—ready to lead, serve, and transform their community.
