



SASHAKT NAARI EMPOWERS TRIBAL WOMEN THROUGH SKILL DEVELOPMENT

Under its women empowerment initiative, Sashakt Naari, Oleevia Foundation organized and fully funded a large-scale skill development training program for members of the Kaveri Self Help Group in Wayanad. The program benefited more than 100 tribal women and was designed to enhance livelihood opportunities, strengthen self-reliance, and equip participants with practical skills that can contribute to sustainable income generation and socio-economic empowerment.

Building Skills for Sustainable Livelihoods

The training program focused on developing employable and entrepreneurial skills among tribal women. Through structured sessions and practical learning opportunities, participants gained exposure to income-generating activities and enterprise development concepts. The initiative aimed to bridge skill gaps while creating pathways for women to actively participate in local economic development and improve the financial well-being of their families.



Strengthening Women-Led Community Development

The program reinforced the critical role of women as drivers of community progress. By empowering members of the Kaveri Self Help Group with new knowledge and skills, the initiative strengthened their confidence to explore livelihood opportunities and contribute to household income.
